Description

Coleman and Fairburn were contracted to refurbish the office space and corridor on Level 3 of the Integrated and Community Health Building at Blacktown Hospital.

These works involved:

- Stripping out the existing fixtures
- Rendering
- Floor coverings
- Fixed acoustic screens
- New ceilings and services
- Painting
- Installation of new joinery to the kitchen area
- New flexible space workstations and quiet booths.

These works increased adaptive-based work areas and provided a multi-use workspace.

A great deal of forward planning was required to ensure suppliers and subcontractors could meet the requirements of the clients and the design produced by the Capital Works team. The works were completed on time and on budget and extra works were requested after completion. The project involved services shutdowns and out of hours works to ensure as little disruption to the staff and users in the area as possible.
